While it is possible to get to Queens by subway and then connecting to a bus, it may take well over an hour and thirty minutes. We strongly recommend that if you do not have a car that you and your teammates do one of the following:

A group can take a car service to Queens College. You should contact the following companies to discuss rates. We recommend calling to arrange for transportation well in advance to guarantee car availability:

- 1. Take a yellow cab to Queens College from a meeting place in Manhattan. It is approximately a 30 minute ride and should cost no more than \$25-\$35.
- 2. Rent a car.
- 3. Follow subway directions out to Main Street and take a cab.

By Subway

Recommended route (approximately 1 to 1.5 hours travel time)

From Grand Central Station, take the 7 train to Main street (one stop past Shea Stadium), then take the Q17 bus (arrives in front of Modells store), or take the Q25/34 bus (arrives in front of McDonald's).

Secondary route (approximately 1 to 1.5 hours travel time)

Take the E or J train to Jamaica Center; transfer to the Q17-Main Street Flushing bus or the Q25/34-125 Street College Point bus.

By Train

From Penn Station, take the Long Island Railroad Port Washington line to Flushing, then take the Q17 bus or the Q25/34 bus (arrives closer to the College, is operated by Queens Surface Corp., and is a different color than MTA buses).

By Car

From New England, take Interstate 95 (New England Thruway) to Interstate 295 to Throgsneck Bridge. After crossing the bridge, go south on Interstate 295 (Clearview Expressway to Exit 4/Long Island Expressway West). Take the Long Island Expressway to Exit 23 (Main Street); at light, turn right, go to the first light and make a left onto Reeves Avenue. Enter at first set of gates.

From Manhattan (approximately 30 minutes), go cross-town east on 42nd Street to Second Ave. Make a right on Second to the Queens Midtown Tunnel. Go through Tunnel to Long Island Expressway (Interstate 495) to Exit 23 (Main Street); at light, turn right, go to the first light and make a left onto Reeves Avenue. Enter at first set of gates.
